2 General InternetUsage Guidelines

2.1 Safe Browsing

Do's:

- ▶ Use updated antivirus and firewall software.
- ▶ Verify website credibility before providing personal information.
- ► Keep software, operating systems, and browsers up to date to protect against vulnerabilities.

Don'ts:

- ▶ Download or install software from untrusted sources.
- ► Click on suspicious links or download attachments from unknown sources.
- ► Share sensitive information (e.g., passwords, financial details) through unsecured websites.

2.2 Respectful Communication

Do's:

Communication through email, social media, and messaging apps while adhering to respectful communication guidelines.

4 Prohibited Internet **Activities**

Engaging in cyberbullying, hate speech, or harassment.



Accessing or sharing explicit or inappropriate content.



Engaging in illegal activities, including piracy, hacking, or fraud.



Circumventing security measures to access unauthorized websites or resources.

5 Consequences for Violations
